Springport Elementary School

Springport Elementary was identified by the State of Michigan as a Reward School based on achievement data from 2015-2016. Springport Elementary was given this distinction for beating the odds by performing better than predicted based on traditional risk factors, and performing the highest in their peer group of similar schools. The staff has worked very hard to provide strong literacy interventions for our students. The staff has imple-

mented GrapeSEED, LLI (Leveled Literacy Intervention) and Informational Reading Strategies throughout the building. The elementary school has also engaged the staff and students through math academy training and a Response to Intervention Math Model. I am very proud of the collaboration of the staff and their excellent work with their students to impact their student achievement.
